Suggested Contest Format




Entry Fee

 \$35 per contestant

Prize Payout

Prize pool based on total entry fees collected.

Suggested payout:

-  1st Place – 60% of prize pool
-  2nd Place – 30% of prize pool
-  3rd Place – Entry fee refunded (\$35)

Prize amounts will vary based on the number of contestants registered.

Contest Rounds

Round 1 – 80's Rock

Contestants perform one song from the 1980s Rock genre.

Judges score performances and advance contestants to the next round.

Round 2 – Country Music

Remaining contestants perform a country song of their choice.

Judges score performances and advance contestants.

Round 3 – Spin the Wheel Challenge

Contestants spin the "Genre Wheel."

Possible genres may include:

- Pop
- Classic Rock
- Disney
- Hip-Hop/Rap
- Broadway
- Alternative
- Boy Bands
- One-Hit Wonders
- Love Songs
- Party Anthems

Contestants perform a song from the selected genre.

Judges narrow the field to the finalists.


Final Round – Sing Your Best

Top 3 finalists perform any song of their choosing.

Judges determine:


 1st Place


 2nd Place

 3rd Place

Judging Criteria

Each performance scored on:

 Vocal Ability (40 points)

 Stage Presence (25 points)

 Song Choice & Difficulty (15 points)

Audience Engagement (20 points)

Total: 100 Points

Contest Rules

- Open to ages 16 and older.
- Contestants must register and pay entry fee before the event. Email kalamafair@gmail.com.
- Songs must be family-friendly and suitable for a community event.
- No original music.
- Contestants may not repeat a song during the competition.
- Contestants are responsible for knowing lyrics.
- Judges' decisions are final.
- Contestants must be present when called to perform or risk disqualification.
- Registration deadline: July 12, 2026 (or until spots are full).
- Contest may be adjusted based on participation numbers.
